Registration now under way for St. Marys River Celebration

Annual river cleanup is March 18

CALLAHAN, Fla., Jan. 26, 2006 — Registration is under way for the 10th annual St. Marys River Celebration river cleanup, scheduled for Saturday, March 18, 2006, in Nassau and Baker counties in Florida and Camden and Charlton counties in Georgia.

The Celebration is a one-day volunteer cleanup of the St. Marys River and its tributaries. Last March, the cleanup drew 571 volunteers, who collected more than 51,000 pounds of trash at 21 cleanup sites. Over the past nine years, nearly 5,000 volunteers have removed more than 417,000 pounds of trash from the river corridor.

The cleanup will take place from 8 a.m. to noon and will be followed with a complimentary lunch for cleanup volunteers at the White Oak Conservation Center. Volunteers also will receive a St. Marys River Celebration T-shirt. Tickets will be distributed to volunteers at the cleanup sites and are required to gain entry to White Oak.
